MILITARY CLOSE QUARTER COMBAT

The Military Close quarter Combat training module was designed using the parameters and scenarios provided by actual soldiers involved in modern operations. The programs cover the following topics:

Module One - Close Quarter Combat

- One/ Two hand Lapel Grab
- Choke
- Bear Hug with Arms Trapped/Free
- Head lock
- Push
- Wrist Grabs (opposite, cross and double)
- Hair Grab
- Front/Side/Roundhouse Kicks
- Straight/Hook Punches
- Overhand Strike
- Shoulder Grab
- Middle arm Grab
- Inside-Outside/Outside-Inside Knife Thrusts
- Knife Slash
- Extended Knife Thrust
- Extended Handgun

Module Two - Close Quarter Combat - Knife to Open Hand

- Open hand defence for neck saber slash
- Open hand defence for femoral artery slash
- Open hand defence for high backslash
- Open hand defence for stab to the heart
- Open hand defence for slash to the lungs
- Open hand defence for strike to the carotid sinuous

Module Three - Close Quarter Combat - Knife to Knife

- Knife to knife defence against high side circular slash
- Knife to knife defence against a high backhand slash
- Knife to knife defence against a low straight thrust
- Knife to knife defence against a high straight thrust
- Knife to knife defence against an overhead thrust

Module Four

- Similar to modules one through three, but rather than mechanical, it is designed to utilize pressure points.

Module Five - Silent Interdiction

- Sentry take-out from behind using a knife
- Sentry take out from behind using a garrot
- Sentry take out from behind using a knife, while sentry is turning
- Sentry take-out from behind, open handed
- Sentry take-out from the front
- Sentry drills

Module Six - Airline Security And Countermeasures

- Edged Weapon To Open Hand Techniques for Personal Protection
- Edged Weapon To Open Hand Escape Techniques
- Edged Weapon to Open Hand Techniques To Protect Others
- Firearm To Open Hand Techniques For Personal Protection
- Extended Firearm to Open Hand Escape Techniques

- Five day program.
- Requires annual refresher/recertification.
